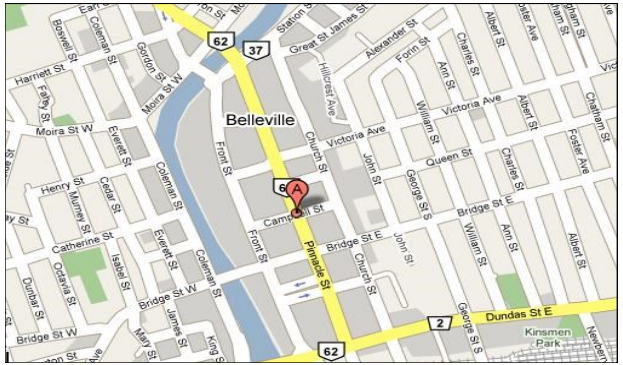


# Library Outreach
