

Getting Started With Overdrive EReader

Installing Required Software

To use eBooks on an eReader, you will need a computer with internet access and will need to download the book to the computer before transferring it to the eReader.

- 1) Download and Install “Adobe Digital Editions”
By Visiting: <http://www.adobe.com/ca/products/digital-editions.html>

Note: Authorize the “ADE” as it will cause problems later if you forget

- 2) Once you have installed it
Go to: <http://downloadcentre.library.on.ca>
- 3) Choose “**Belleville Public Library**” and Sign into your account with your library card
- 4) Browse the available books by subject, or with the search field

Tip: You can use the top left navigation icon to narrow your search which looks like:



- 5) To find books that can be borrowed immediately apply filter “Available Now” when looking at your search results.
- 6) Click on the book/album cover and click either “Borrow” or “Place a Hold”
- 7) The item when available will be “automatically checked out” unless you click otherwise.
- 8) Choose DOWNLOAD
- 9) The file should open in “Adobe Digital Editions” (ADE)

Note: If the book does not automatically open in “Adobe Digital Editions”, you may need to click on the download file to open it.

- 10) Plug in your eReader to your computer. Your eReader should now be listed under “Devices” in ADE
- 11) Click and Drag book to the device bookshelf on the left. Should see a green + (plus sign) when correct.
- 12) After the download is complete, eject your device from your computer. Your eReader should now be processing new content.
