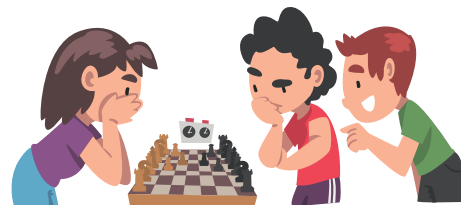
YOUTH CHESS CLUB
